THIS DEED OF TRUST

Made and executed at Kishanganj, this day, Wednesday, the 7th of February 2001.

BETWEEN

Ejaz Ahmed Md. Haroon S/o Late Badruddin Ahmed, aged about 45 years, resident of Goagaon (estate), P.S. Goalpokher, Distt. Uttar Dinajpur, West Bengal hereinafter referred to as the **SETTLOR** (which expression shall unless repugnant to the context mean and include his heirs and assigns), **THE PARTY OF THE ONE PART**

All Muslims by religion, hereinafter jointly and collectively referred to as TRUSTEE (which expression shall unless repugnant to the context or meaning, thereof, mean and include the survivor or survivors of them or other Trustee or Trustees for the time being appointed in the manner hereinafter laid down) OF THE OTHER PART.

WHEREAS under the provision of Article 30(I), Constitution of India, the SETTLOR is desirous of setting aside a sum of Rs. 25,000/- (Rupees Twenty Five Thousand and paise nil) only upon an Education and Welfare Trust for the benefit of the Minority Communities in general and the Muslim Minority Community in particular.

AND whereas the Trustees have agreed to become the FIRST TRUSTEES of the said Trust as testified by their being parties to and executing these presents.

AND whereas the SETTLOR has paid and made over the sum of Rs. 25,000/- (Rupees Twenty Five Thousand and paise nil) only.

AND whereas the SETTLOR has decided to make proper arrangements for the Constitution and running of the Trust, he has decided to reduce into writing the arrangements agreed for.

NOW THIS DEED OF TRUST WITNESSETH AND IT IS HEREBY AGREED AS FOLLOWS:

1. For effectuating the said desire of the SETTLOR, the SETTLOR does hereby assign and transfer unto the TRUSTEES a sum of Rs. 25,000/- (Rupees Twenty Five Thousand) only. (The receipt whereof the TRUSTEES do hereby admit and acknowledge) to have and to hold the same and the accumulation thereof and accretion thereto including donations and the investments thereof for the time being upon TRUST for the objects and

purposes hereafter expressed with the powers and on terms and conditions hereinafter declared.

2. For effectuating the said desire of the SETTLOR and in the consideration of these promises, the TRUSTEES do hereby agree and declare that they shall and will hold and stand possessed of the said some of Rs. 25,000/- (Rupees Twenty Five Thousand) only made over to them as aforesaid, and such further sums of donations and subscriptions as may be received from time to time by the TRUSTEES and other persons and all the income thereof, with all accumulations thereof, and the additions and accretions thereto, and the investments for representing the same (all of which shall be hereafter referred to as the TRUST FUND) upon the Trust under the conditions, provisions and declarations concerning the same and hereinafter contained.

3. The TRUST shall be known as CRESCENT EDUCATION AND WELFARE TRUST.

4. **OBJECTS:**

The Trust shall take benefit of right granted by the Constitution of India under Article 30(I).

The Trust shall utilise its power and resources for the benefit and welfare of Minority Community and the Muslim Minority in particular.

Its shall endeavour and uphold the cause of service to humanity.

The Trust shall, however, be entitled to consider the fields of its action from amongst the following areas of peoples' cause, anywhere within the Indian Territory, as may be suited for the purpose.

A. EDUCATION

- I. Setting up of Minority Educational Institutions for the promotion of advanced knowledge in Science, Arts, Literature, etc.
- II. Setting up of various Minority Vocational Institutions to avail the students of latest Technical and Professional Courses.
- III. To undertake research works on various fields of activities.
- IV. To organise Seminars, Conferences, Discourses, Symposia, etc.; for sharing the views and opinions with the experts of the fields concerned.
- V. Promoting Adult Education and creating awareness among the masses for the same.
- VI. Advancement and promotion of Games and Sports by establishing Clubs, Stadia, Gymnasias, etc.; and organising various sports meets.
- VII. To support and encourage any government, semi-government or non-government organisation working in the field of education by providing venue, volunteers, etc.
- VIII. To take various measures for the promotion and popularisation of Urdu Language and Literature.

Apart from the task of establishing various institutions, the TRUST shall also be entitled to:

- a) Undertake any institution, already existing at the time of its inception or coming into existence after its inception, and thus providing all kinds of help as may be sought by the concerned institution.
- b) Provide support, financial or otherwise, to any institution in need.

B. RELIEF AND WELFARE

The TRUST shall endeavour to take the following measures for welfare of the masses.

- I. To undertake various relief measures for the victims of natural calamities, accidents, disasters, etc.; and do the needful for their rehabilitation.
- II. To render medical relief and assistance to the pauper and establish health centres in rural areas.
- III. To provide support — moral, financial or otherwise — to the handicapped, destitute and the under privileged section of the society.

C. ENVIRONMENT

Environment has a significant role to play in an individual's mental and physical growth and the TRUST shall, to the best of its capacity, try to impart environment based education and caution the people against the adverse effects of polluting the environment and misusing the natural resources (because of their ignorance).

It shall organise seminars, symposia, exhibitions, demonstrations, etc.; highlighting the importance and essentiality of an idyllic environment; and promote eco-friendly practices such as plantation, conservation of water and soil, cleansing water sources, etc.

D. NATIONAL INTEGRITY

India's strength lies in its 'Unity in Diversity' and the TRUST shall not, at any cost, bargain this strength of the nation. Moreover, it shall follow the path that leads to

E. INFORMATION AND BROADCASTING

The TRUST shall publish books, magazines, periodicals, journals, souvenirs, booklets, posters, handbills, etc.; which shall be helpful in the advancement, promotion and spread of education and enhance the ethical and moral character of the society.

5. BOARD OF TRUSTEES

- I. There shall be a 'Board of Trustees' which shall consist of the signatories of these presents.
- II. The Board of Trustees shall have the distinction of being the supreme authority of the TRUST. All other authorities shall act and operate under the auspices of the Board of Trustees.
- III. The number of Trustees in the Board of Trustees shall not be less than two and more than seven at any given point of time. The Board shall cease to exist if its membership falls below the minimum number required. In such a case, the remainder shall have the power to appoint Trustees to fulfill the minimum requirement of the Board of Trustees.
- IV. Any Trustee is at liberty to resign from the Trust on giving one month's prior information in writing of his or her intention to do so.
- V. A person shall cease to be a Trustee if he/she:
 - a) Does not attend three consecutive meetings of the Board of Trustees.
 - b) Is requested to resign either by the ¾ (Three-fourths) of the Trustees or by the Chairman himself.
- VI. **GHOLAM SHAHID** shall be the **Chairman** while **MD. HANIF ALAM** shall be the **Vice-Chairman** and **RIZWAN MUBASSHIR** shall be the **Treasurer** for life.

6. CHAIRMAN

The Board of Trustees shall be headed by a Chairman, who, in his capacity as the Chief Executive of the Board of Trustees, shall have the following powers.

- I. He shall convene and preside over the meetings of the Board of Trustees.
- II. He shall have the power to seek resignation of any member of the Board of Trustees.

8. TREASURER

The Treasurer, with the permission of the Board of Trustees, shall collect and receive all subscriptions, donations, contributions, etc.; and grant receipt thereof. He shall maintain and keep cash books and such accounts and vouchers as are necessary.

9. POWERS AND FUNCTIONS OF THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES

- I. The Board of Trustees shall be at liberty at their discretion to accept any property, contributions, collections, donations, etc.; from any person(s), firm or company, or other institutions for the advancement of the objects of the Trust.
- II. The Board of Trustees shall be at liberty to sell any Trust Property and to utilise the sale proceeds in any manner considered expedient and to transfer or to transpose any such investment as the Board of Trustees may, from time to time, think fit within the scope of the Trust.
- III. The Board of Trustees may appoint regular, permanent, part time or honorary staff, if necessary.
- IV. The Board of Trustees shall have the power to frame rules and regulations to carry out various objects and purposes of the Trust and to alter, add or delete the same from time to time.
- V. It shall be lawful for the Board of Trustees to delegate any of its powers to any other or more Trustees, jointly or separately, and, if necessary, to cancel or modify the same.
- VI. The Board of Trustees shall be entitled to authorise, by resolution, any one or more Trustees or any other persons, jointly or separately, to receive money payable to the Trust and to pass receipt for the same.
- VII. The Board of Trustees shall have the powers to enter into contracts and to borrow money as may be considered necessary by the Trustees for financing any charitable work declared under these presents.
- VIII. It shall be lawful for the Board of Trustees to file, withdraw, compromise or compound any action suit or proceedings relating to the Trust and/or to refer any such differences or demands to arbitration and/or to execute instruments and all things necessary or expedite for such purposes or any of them.
- IX. The Board of Trustees shall have the powers to amalgamate with and take over other Trust(s) having wholly charitable objects.
- X. The Board of Trustees shall open Bank Account in the name of the Trust, in respect of the Trust Fund, and such account shall be operated upon by the Chairman in tandem with any one or more members of the Board of Trustees.
- XI. The Board of Trustees shall have the power to make rules and regulations for those circumstances where this deed is silent.

10. DUTIES AND OBLIGATIONS OF THE TRUSTEES

- I. The Board of Trustees shall be wholly responsible for the realisation of the aims and objectives of the Trust.
- II. The Board of Trustees shall, out of the Trust Fund pay all management charges, expenses, salaries, etc.; and other expenses related to the management and

- administration of the Trust in the first instance (and shall utilise the net income for the charitable objects aforesaid).
- III. Any Trust Property held in the name of any outgoing or dead trustee shall automatically stand transferred with all convenient despatch from his name to the Board of Trustees.
 - IV. A Trustee shall be answerable for only such moneys or securities or other properties which he or she shall actually receive notwithstanding his/her signing any receipt or advanced receipt.
 - V. All securities and funds of trust shall be kept in the name of the Trust.

11. MEETINGS, QUORUM, RESOLUTIONS

- I. The Board of Trustees shall meet as often as necessary but a minimum of four(4) meetings must be held in a year.
- II. Meetings of the Board of Trustees shall be convened by the Chairman or by the person authorised by him for this purpose.
- III. At least one-third (1/3) of the total number of Trustees reporting within half an hour of the scheduled time shall form the quorum. If there is no quorum even after the expiry of half an hour, the meeting shall stand adjourned to such a date, hour and place as may be fixed by the Chairman of the Board of Trustees.
- IV. The Trustees present at the meetings shall elect a President of the meeting unless the Chairman of the Trust chooses to preside over the meeting himself.
- V. In the case of difference of opinion among the Trustees, the votes of the majority of the Trustees shall prevail over the minority as well as on those Trustees who may not have remained present or voted. In case of a tie of votes, the matter shall be decided by the vote cast by the president.
- VI. Meetings of the Board of Trustees shall be convened at such a place in India and at such an hour and on such a date as may be agreed upon by the Board of Trustees or fixed by the Chairman.
- VII. The Board of Trustees shall keep minute book of the proceedings of its meetings, proper books of accounts and other details of its activities.

12. VACANCIES AND APPOINTMENTS

If any Trustee, either original or appointed under these presents in pursuance of the provisions contained, dies or be desirous of being relieved, or refuses to act, or becomes unfit or incapable to act in the duties or powers reposed in him or her, or convicted of criminal offence involving moral turpitude, or hereunder these presents be declared insolvent; he or she shall cease to be a Trustee and thereupon a vacancy shall be deemed to have arisen in the Board of Trustees. The Board of Trustees shall appoint a new Trustee to fill up the vacancy so created.

13. MANAGING COMMITTEE

There shall be one or more managing committees to supervise and have control over the functions and activities of the different institutions run by the Trust.

- I. The Managing Committee(s) shall consist of at least seven members of which not more than five members will be from among the Board of Trustees. The rest of the members will be nominated from amongst the dignitaries and luminaries of the society.
- II. The Managing Committee(s) shall carry out the tasks as delegated to it from time to time by a resolution of the Board of Trustees.
- III. A Managing Committee shall be collectively responsible to the Board of Trustees.
- IV. Term of a Managing Committee shall be for two years.
- V. Quorum for meeting of a Managing Committee shall be one-third (1/3) of the total members of the Managing Committee.
- VI. The Vice-Chairman of the Board of Trustee shall be the SECRETARY of a Managing Committee.

14. ADVISORY COMMITTEE

For Trust as a whole or for each of its establishment there may be an Advisory Committee consisting of experts in various fields, political dignitaries, social workers and research scholars who may be nominated by the Board of Trustees on the recommendation of the Managing Committee(s) for such term as the Board of Trustees may specify.

15. OFFICE

The Trust shall maintain its office at Sir Syed Nagar, Kishanganj, Bihar where all the books of accounts belonging to the Trust shall be kept and where business in connection with the administration and management of the Trust shall also be transacted. Trust Office can be transferred to any other place in India, if so desired by the three-fourths (3/4) majority of the Board of Trustees. The Board of Trustees may open any branches of the Trust, and may close the same in any part of the country.
